

4. Limitations

You need to ask yourself - what point does this source stop being of value? Has the author – left anything out, not known the whole story? Ask yourself does this source have bias?

Step 1: Ask yourself how is the source limited

1. How reliable is the source?

2. Is it objective or subjective?

3. Are there political, institutional, religious, cultural, ideological or personal biases?

These questions are only starters this part requires you to critically look at the source and find limitations that are reducing the value of the source. Remember there are always limitations!
